NORMS OF COLLABORATION

- ✓ Presume positive intentions: this is my best thinking at this time—my ideas can change as I learn and grow
- ✓ Let's be hard on ideas and soft on people
- ✓ Demonstrate mutual respect for everyone's perspective, pace and journey. We are all learning
- ✓ Employ skillful listening
- ✓ Trust and be trustworthy
- ✓ Balance participation: every voice needs to be heard
